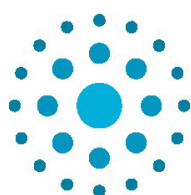

FOR UNIVERSITIES  
IN CHILE**

**2024 - 2026**





## PURPOSE OF THE CALL

Université Côte d'Azur (UniCA) aims to develop its international collaborations, in particular with Chile and more specifically with:

- Universidad de Chile (la U).
- Universidad de Concepción (UdeC).
- Universidad de Católica de Chile (la Católica).
- Universidad de Santiago de Chile (Usach).
- Universidad de O'Higgins.

In partnership with the Department of International Development and Europe (DDIE) and IdEx, the Formal, Physical and Engineering Sciences Graduate School also known as SPECTRUM is offering grants for stays between January 2025 and July 2026 at the universities mentioned above to its staff (including UniCA PhD students) with recognized expertise in mathematics, physics, astrophysics, chemistry and/or earth sciences (B2 level of English required).

## NUMBER OF GRANTS OFFERED AND DURATION

- 4 stays of various lengths each for doctoral students.

(Details: 2 three-month stays at the Universidad de Chile, 1 one-month stay at the UdeC and 1 one-month stay at the Católica).

- 6 visits of 12 days each for teaching\* or training/observation activities for UniCA faculty and scientific engineers, also open to CNRS and INRIA researchers and scientific engineers.

(Details: 2 stays at Universidad de Chile; 1 stay at UdeC; 1 stay at Católica; 1 stay at Usach; 1 stay at O'Higgins).

\* Faculty may include teaching hours in their teaching schedule.

## Funding

Mobility grant for PhD: 700€ per month

Subsistence allowance for staff: 180€ per day

Round-trip travel package for all participants: 1500€

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Subject to compliance with the following eligibility conditions, applicants may apply for one of the proposed mobility programs:

1) Doctoral stay: any doctoral student registered at UniCA during the desired period of mobility, affiliated with the Ecole Doctorale Sciences Fondamentales et Ingénierie (EDSFA) and assigned to one of the laboratories listed in item 2) below.

2) Short-term stay: any faculty member, researcher or scientific engineer from the CRHEA, INPHYNI, ARTEMIS, LAGRANGE, GEOAZUR, ICN and JAD laboratories.

## TIMETABLE OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis. They must be submitted at least 3 months before the actual departure date.

Various sessions will be organized:

- 1) Deadline: October 15, 2024. Results communicated no later than November 15, 2024.  
Mobility between January 2025 and August 2025.
- 2) Deadline: May 15, 2025. Result communicated no later than June 15, 2025.  
Mobility between September 2025 and January 2026.
- 3) Deadline: October 15, 2025. Result communicated no later than November 15, 2025.  
Mobility between January 2026 and July 2026.

## HOW TO APPLY

You will have to send your application documents written in English, in a single PDF file named "acronym of the University of destination\_type of stay\_last name of the candidate\_first name of the candidate\_name of the Chilean-hosting-laboratory".

The documents listed below are required:

- A Curriculum Vitae.
- A letter of motivation setting out your scientific project. It should prove how the stay will serve long-term collaborations with the chosen university.
- A letter of invitation from the Chilean host laboratory.
- An evaluation form to be completed by your immediate supervisor (see attached).
- An authorization form completed by your lab and your PhD school head (see attached).

In addition, in the case of a doctoral stay:

- A master's transcript showing your ranking.
- A letter of recommendation from your supervisor and the source of funding for your current thesis.
- A doctoral mobility agreement signed by ED SFA and your laboratory.

## SELECTION PROCESS

Grant recipients will be selected by the SPECTRUM Graduate School committee.

Applications will be assessed on the basis of the candidate's profile and skills, and on the proven prospects offered by the project in terms of long-term collaboration between the two universities (added value provided by this stay in terms of sharing know-how, interdisciplinarity or future prospects - future post-doctorate, student exchange, etc.).
